

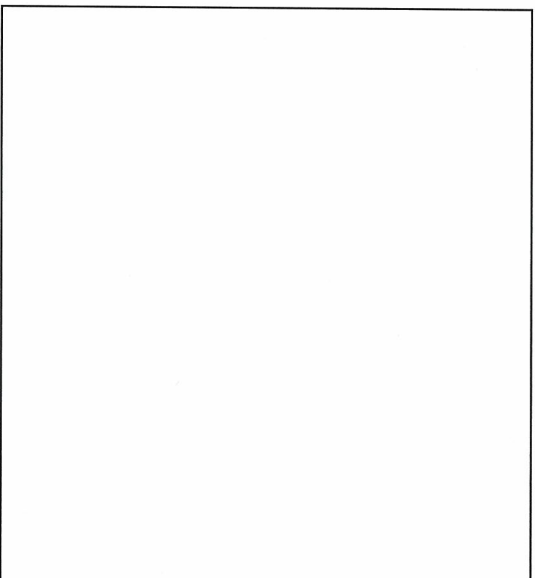

IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ THE LABEL COMPLETELY BEFORE USE

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: Contains 102g/litre chlorothalonil and 125g/litre thiophanate-methyl in the form of a suspension concentrate

WARNING: This product is corrosive and may cause severe eye irritation and eye damage. May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Toxic to human kidneys if taken orally at repeated high doses. Suspected of causing cancer or genetic defects. May cause mild skin irritation or an allergic skin reaction. Very toxic to the aquatic environment. Toxic to the soil environment, mammals, birds, and fish.

PRECAUTIONS: Keep out of reach of children. Avoid contact with the eyes, skin and inhalation of spray mist. Wear protective gloves and eye protection when mixing or using. Use product in well-ventilated areas. Wash hands and exposed skin thoroughly after use. DO NOT contaminate any water supply or fishponds with product or empty container. DO NOT allow spray to drift onto desirable plants, aquatic environment or outside the target area. Keep children, pets, wildlife and birds away from treated areas until the spray is dry.

RECORD KEEPING: Records of use must be kept if using more than 200mL of product within 24 hours.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Store in original container, tightly closed, locked away from children and foodstuffs. Dispose of this product only by using according to the label or at an approved landfill. Rinse empty container, puncture, and recycle or dispose of safely with domestic rubbish.

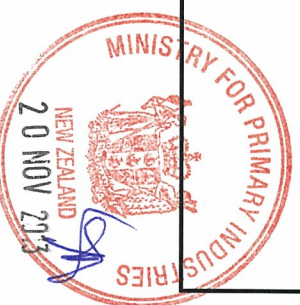

FIRST AID: If swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting. For advice, contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. If splashed in eyes, wash out immediately with running water for at least 15 minutes and seek medical attention. If inhaled move the victim to fresh air immediately. Begin artificial respiration if breathing has stopped.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Greenguard is a general garden fungicide with protectant, curative and systemic activity.

DIRECTIONS: Shake well. Measure the correct amount of Greenguard into water and stir well. Spray plants thoroughly. Apply at first sign of disease and then at 10-14 day intervals.

WITHHOLDING PERIODS: Beans and potatoes – allow 14 days between spraying and harvest. Grapes – allow 28 days. Stonefruit – do not apply after flowering. All other crops – allow 7 days.

COMPATIBILITY: Do not mix with Lime Sulphur Bordeaux mixtures, oil or emulsifiable concentrate formulations.
